UNIT CHECK-IN: Performers and seven (7) staff will be admitted at guard check-in. All guard members and staff must be wrist banded when checking in. Additional staff members and chaperones must purchase tickets from the ticket booth. Units must check-in one (1) hours prior to their performance time. If you have any circuit obligations you will be asked to take care of them at that time. Check-in will be open at 11:00am.

PARKING: Please review the map included in this packet for details on parking at Colonial High School.

DRESSING FACILITIES: Locker rooms will be open for performers. Please vacate in a timely manner to allow space for other performing units. Colonial High School and the Florida Federation of Colorguards Circuit will not be responsible for lost, stolen or damaged property.

FOOTWEAR & EQUIPMENT: All equipment, tips of poles, sabers, and rifles must be properly taped. Any props used must be protected to avoid damage to the gym area. Soft-soled shoes need not extra protection. Hard-soled shoes must be taped. All floor carts and rolling equipment or instruments must have clean working wheels. All equipment must also be removed from the gym immediately following your performance.

INSPECTIONS: Equipment and props will be inspected in the holding area prior to the performance time. Questions regarding your equipment's legality will be determined by the Contest Director and Chief Judge assigned by the FFCC.

FLOOR SIZE: Contest floor will be 55" X 80". We will also have another floor that will be down for added protection throughout the day. If you are bringing your own floor, your floor will have to go over the floor provided.

TABULATING AND JUDGING AREA: Only authorized personnel will be allowed in the tabulation and judging area. DO NOT APPROACH THE TABULATION AREA AT ANY TIME! You may pick up your judges commentary CD's at the trophy table approximately 30 minutes after your units performance.

SHOW MUSIC: Show music CD's should be turned in to the sound table at least 30 minutes prior to the unit's performance time. If you are using an MP3 player the circuit can connect it to the sound system, but will not be responsible for its operation. A guard staff member must be present to operate the player.

SOUND CHECKS: Sound check will take place from 12:00pm-1:00pm. After this time, sound checks will only take place during official breaks when the sound technician is available.

WARM-UPS: There will be ample space provided for your unit's preparation for the show. Colorguards will do body warm up in the bandroom and equipment warm up in the auditorium. We request that you adhere to the rotation schedule to keep the show on schedule. There is also ample outside space for warm-up. However, you will still need to report to the holding area at your designated report time.

AWARDS CEREMONY/RETREAT: We will be having 2 awards ceremonies. The first will be at approximately 3:45 and the second at the conclusion of the contest.

VIDEO TAPING: Each unit will be given a video pass at check-in. This allows one person to video that unit only. Cameras must be hand-held or mounted on a unipod or folded tripod. No other videotaping is allowed.

PHOTOGRAPHY: Photography is allowed, but we do ask that for the comfort and safety of both the performers and the spectators, NO FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY!!!!

GUARD GRAMS: We will have guard grams available for a cost of \$1. The announcer will use discretion when reading guard grams. Inappropriate messages will not be read and no refund will be provided.

CONCESSION STAND: Our concession stand will be open from 12 pm to approximately 8:00 pm.

HOSPITALITY ROOMS: There will be separate hospitality rooms for judges and directors. Please stop and enjoy the food and drinks.

CRITIQUE: Critique will be held after the competition for those units which have previously signed up. Critique will be held in the judges' hospitality room. The critique schedule is available on the event page at the FFCC website.

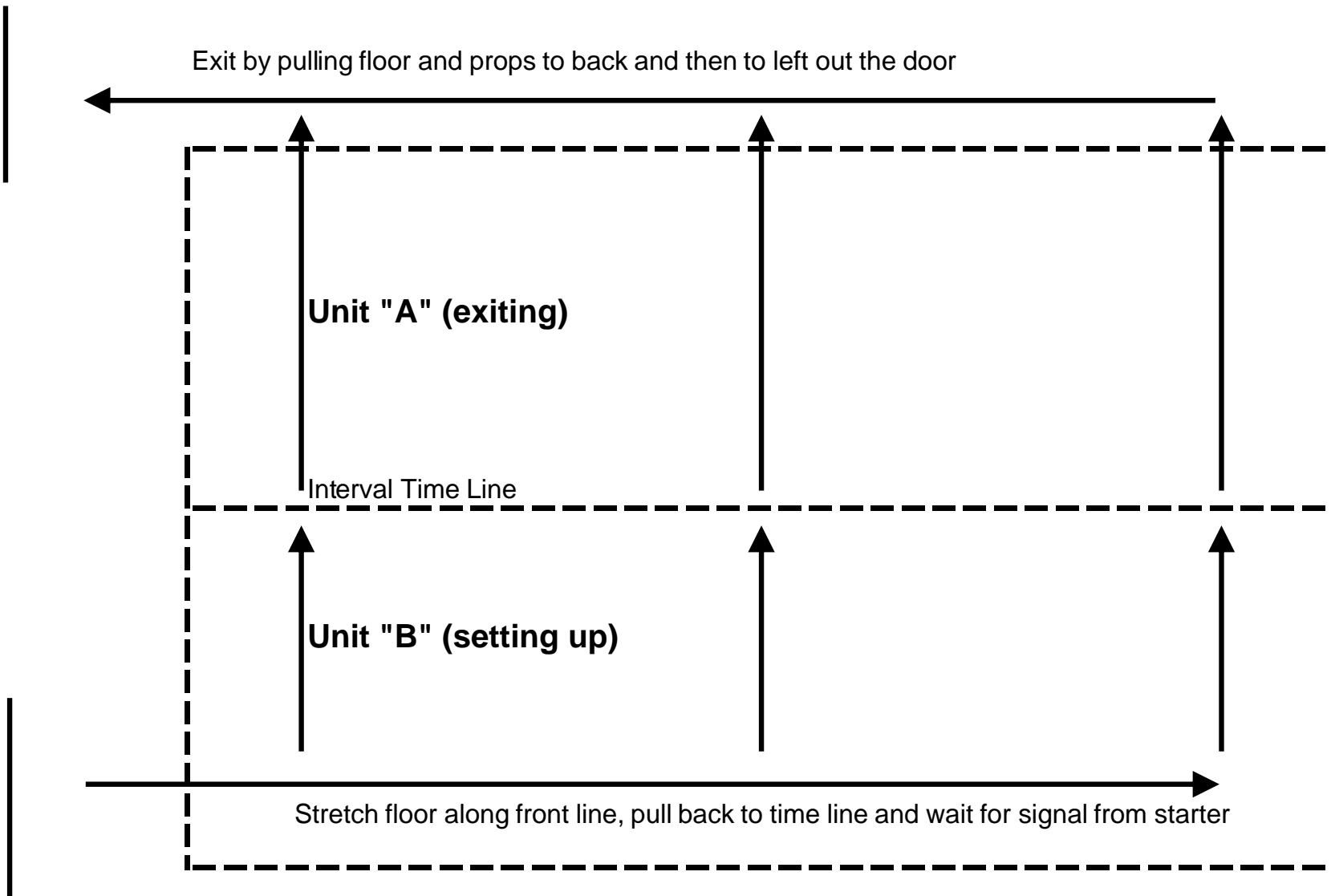

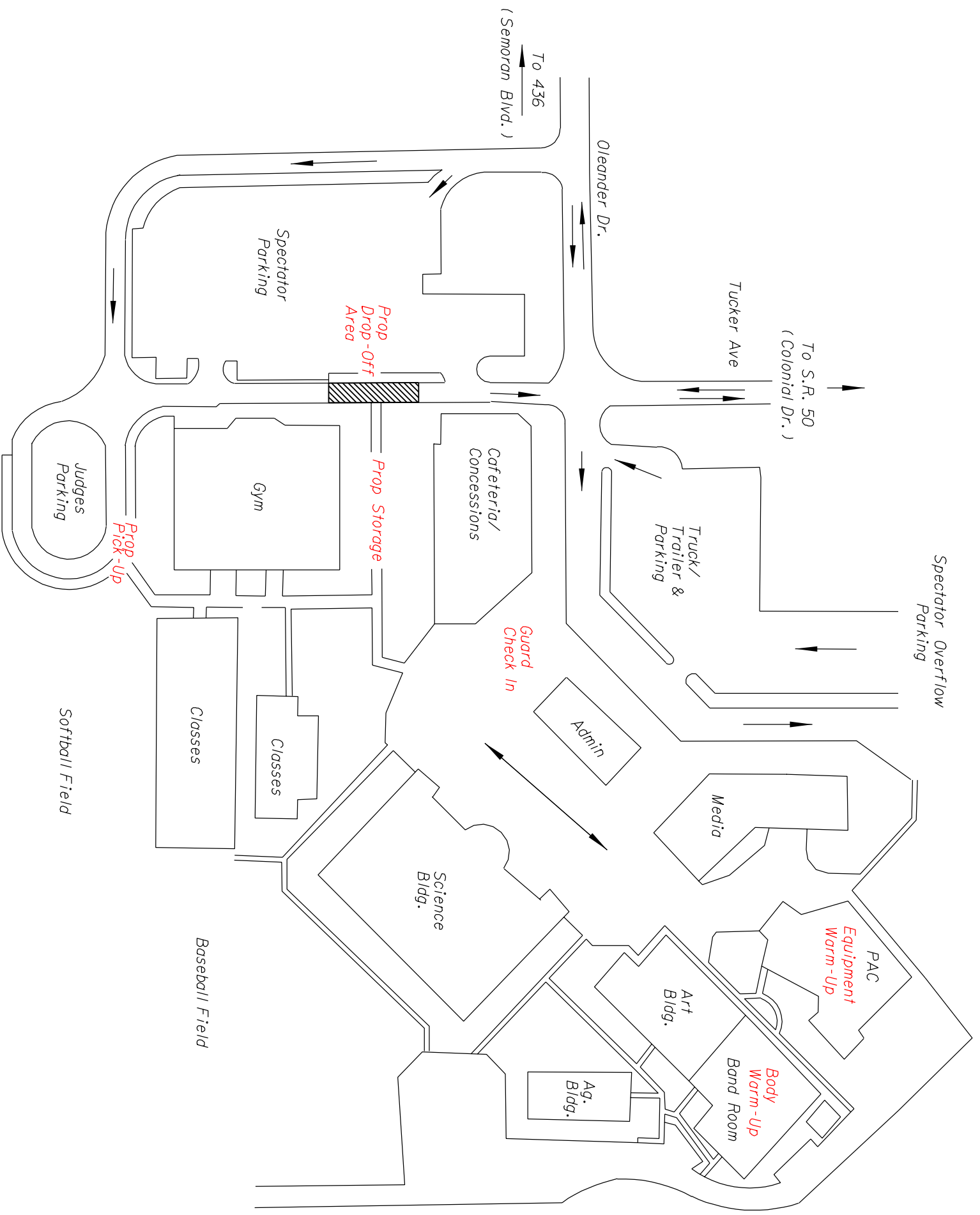

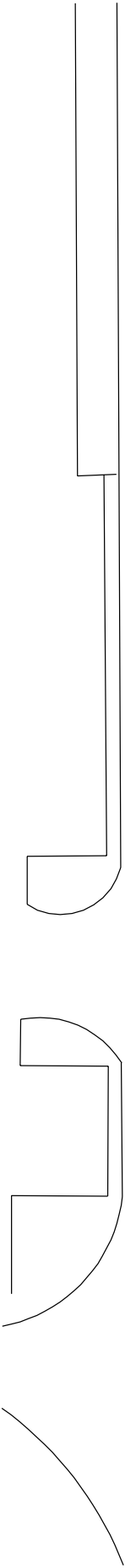

From the North:

Take ramp onto US-1 SOUTH toward I-95 SOUTH
Take the I-95 SOUTH (Left) exit
Take exit #260B onto I-4 WEST toward ORLANDO
Take exit #101AB onto FL-417 SOUTH toward SANFORD/INT'L AIRPORTS
Take exit #34/FL-50 toward COLONIAL DR
Turn on Right on E COLONIAL DR [FL-50]
Turn on Left onto TUCKER AVE
TUCKER AVE becomes OLEANDER DR
Arrive at 6100 OLEANDER DR, ORLANDO on Left

From the South:

Take I-95 NORTH
Take exit #205 onto FL-528 WEST toward ORLANDO
Take exit #16/FL-417-TOLL onto FL-417 NORTH toward SANFORD/ORLANDO
Take exit #33B/FL-408 TOLL WEST onto FL-408 WEST toward ORLANDO
Take exit #14 toward INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT/SEMORAN BLVD
Turn on Left on CAMELLIA DR
Turn on Right SEMORAN BLVD [FL-436]
Turn on Right onto OLEANDER DR
Arrive at 6100 OLEANDER DR, ORLANDO

From the West:

I-4 EAST toward ORLANDO
Take exit #82A/FL-408-TOLL onto FL-408 EAST
Take exit #14 onto LAKE UNDERHILL RD toward INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT/SEMORAN BLVD
Turn on SEMORAN BLVD [FL-436]
Turn on OLEANDER DRIVE
Arrive at 6100 OLEANDER DR, ORLANDO

From the East:
