Date & Time: March 6, 2010
Beginning @ 2:00 p.m.

Tickets: \$10.00

Unit Check-In: Performing members & seven (7) staff will be admitted and must check-in together. All guard members & staff must be wrist-banded when checking in. Additional staff members must purchase tickets. You will be able to purchase tickets at the ticket booth for any additional staff & chaperones. Units must check-in one (1) hour prior to their performance time. Check-in will open at 12:30pm.

Parking: Please review the map included with this packet for details on parking at Winter Park High School. Spectators will be asked to park in B-Lot, located via the main school entrance (2100 Summerfield Rd.) Vehicles carrying floors and equipment as well as busses will be directed to C-Lot via Lindale or Bellwood Dr. entrances (see driving directions/map)

Dressing Facilities: Locker rooms will be open for performers to change. Please vacate in a timely fashion to allow space for other guards. Winter Park High School and the Florida Federation of Colorguards Circuit will not be responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged property.

Footwear & Equipment: All equipment tips of rifles, poles and sabres must be passed. Any props used must be protected with tape and/or padding to avoid damaging the floor. Soft-soled shoes need no protection. Hard-soled shoes must be taped. All carts and rolling equipment must have clean, working wheels.

Inspections: Equipment and props will be inspected in the holding area prior to the performance. Questions regarding your equipments legality will be determined by the Contest Director and Chief Judge assigned by the FFCC.

Floor Size: Contest floor will be at least 55" x 80". We will have a floor that will be down for added protection. If you are bringing a floor, your floor will go over the floor provided.

Equipment Removal: All equipment MUST be removed from the gym immediately following your performance.

Tabulating & Judging Area: Only authorized personnel will be allowed in the tabulating and judging area. DO NOT APPROACH THE TABULATION TABLE! You may pick up your judges tapes and show music at the trophy table approximately 30 minutes after your unit's performance.

Show Music: Show music CD's should be turned in to the sound table at least 30 minutes prior to the unit's performance time. If you are using an MP3 player the circuit can connect it to the sound system, but will not be responsible for its operation. A guard staff member must be present to operate the player.

Sound Checks: This will take place from 1:00pm - 1:55pm. After this scheduled time, sound checks will only take place during official show breaks when our sound technician is available.

Warm-Ups: There will be ample space provided for your unit's preparation for the show. There will be separate body and equipment warm-up areas. These two areas are located in the 600 Building. We request that you adhere to the rotations schedule to keep the show on schedule. These facilities will be inside. If you choose, there is ample outside space for warm-up. You still need to report to the holding area at your designated report time.

Awards Ceremony: There will be two (2) retreat ceremonies. The first retreat is for the Novice, B, AAA Classes and will begin approximately 4:45 PM. The second retreat is for the AA, A, and Open Classes and will begin approximately 9:15 PM. These awards presentations will be with captains only.

Video Taping: Video taping will be permitted with a VIDEO PASS for your unit only. Cameras must be hand-held or mounted on a folded tri-pod. There will not be a video area set aside.

Photography: Photography is allowed, but we do ask for the comfort and safety of both the performers and spectators NO FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY!

Guard Shout-Outs: We will have shout-outs available for a cost of \$1.00 each. The Announcer will use discretion when reading "Shout-Outs". Inappropriate messages will not be read and no refund will be provided.

Programs: Programs will be available throughout the day in the gym lobby for a cost of \$2.00.

Souvenir Tables: Souvenir tables will be available at a cost of \$25.00 for circuit members and \$75.00 for non-circuit members. To reserve a space, please contact Terry Forrester at (407) 620-9071.

Concession Stand: Our concession stand will be open from 1:00 pm until approximately 9:30pm. Among the items we will be serving are hamburgers, cheeseburgers, hot dogs, barbecue pork, nachos, baked goods, assorted candies, bottled water, gatorade, soft drinks and coffee.

Hospitality Room: There will be a Hospitality Room available for Directors which will include food and drinks. Please stop by and enjoy. ☺

Head North on Semoran (SR 436) to Lake Baldwin Ln.

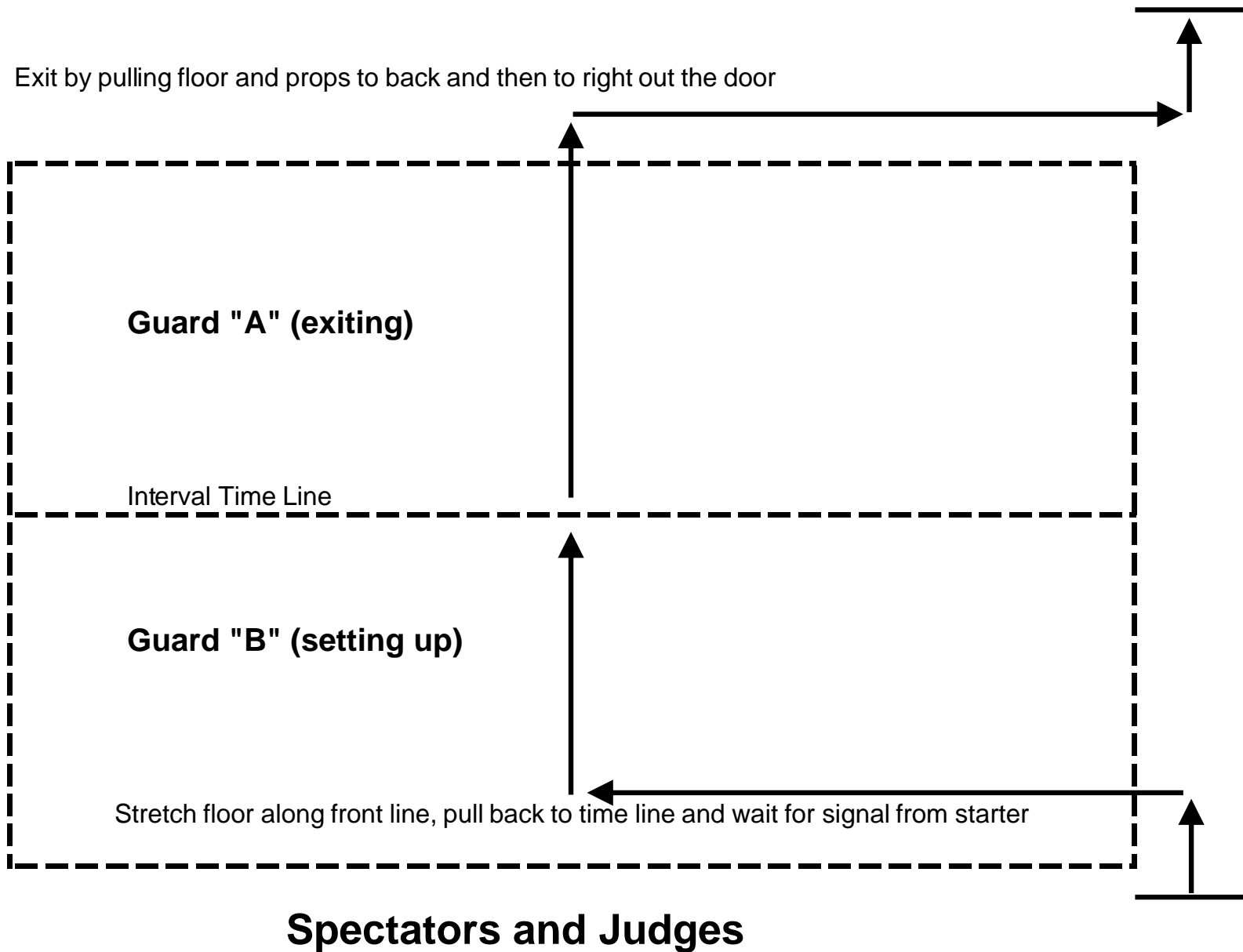
Left on Baldwin Park St.

Right on Lindale Ave. → dead ends into school (narrow street)

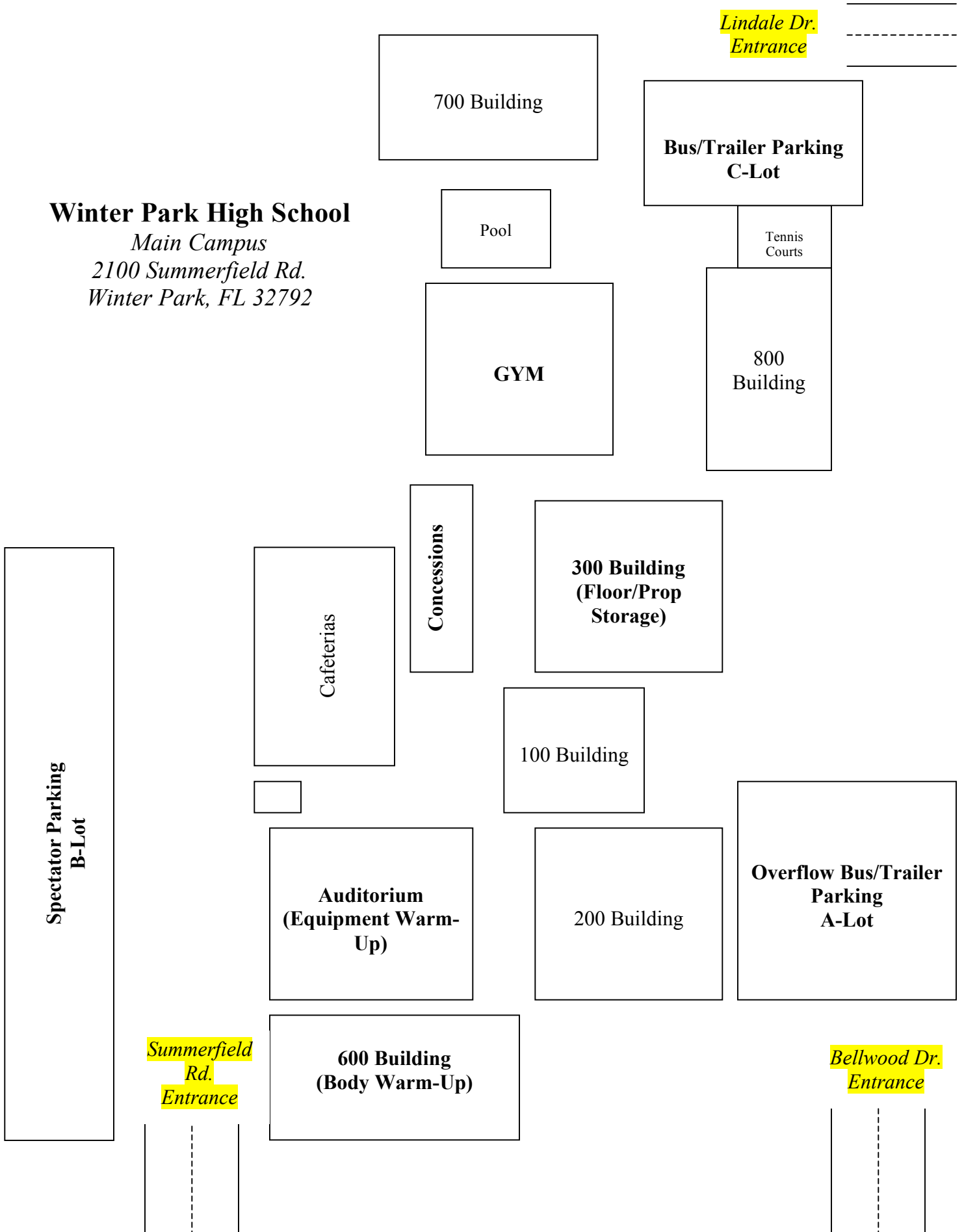
Continue straight and bus/trailer parking will be on right
